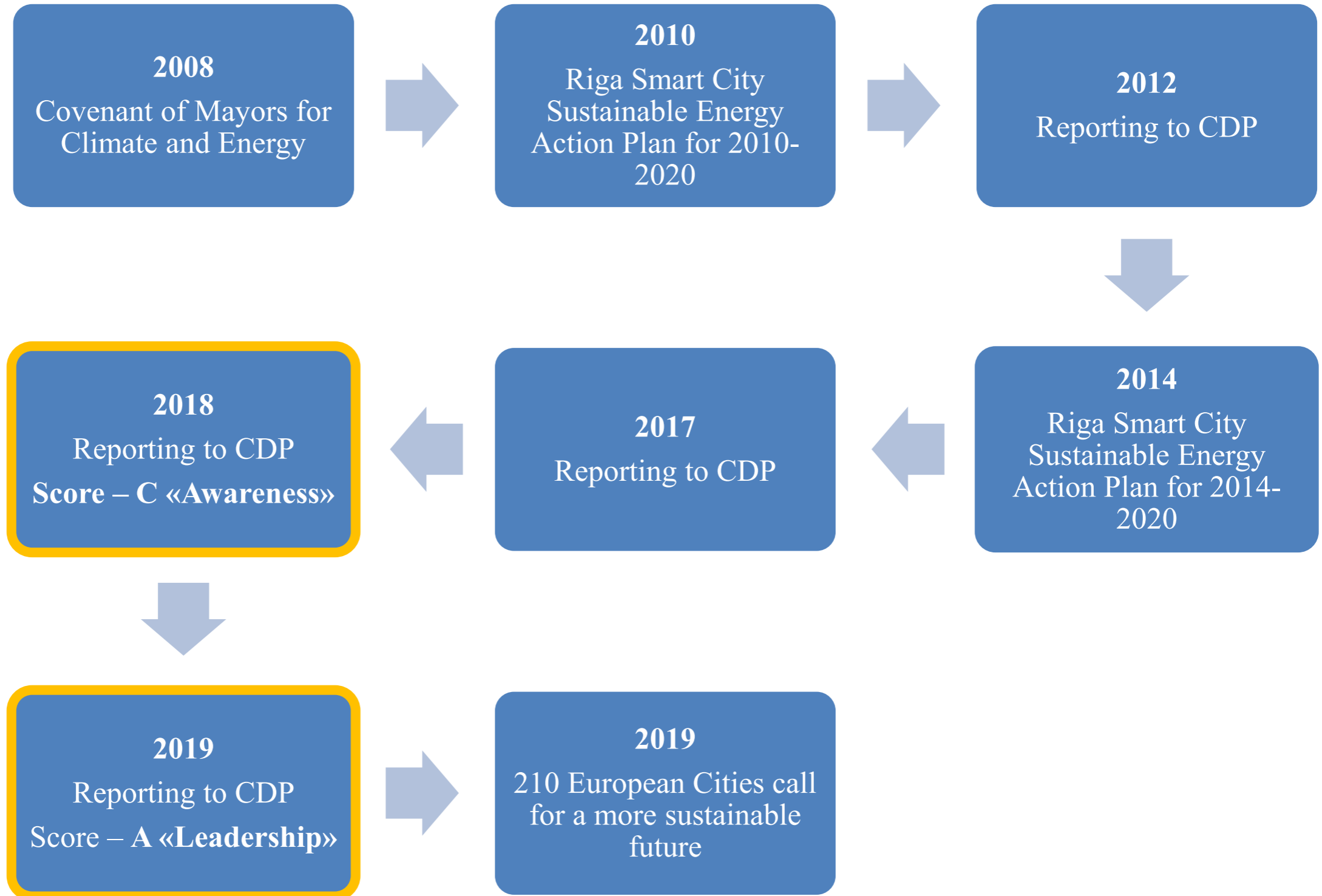

- Sources of information



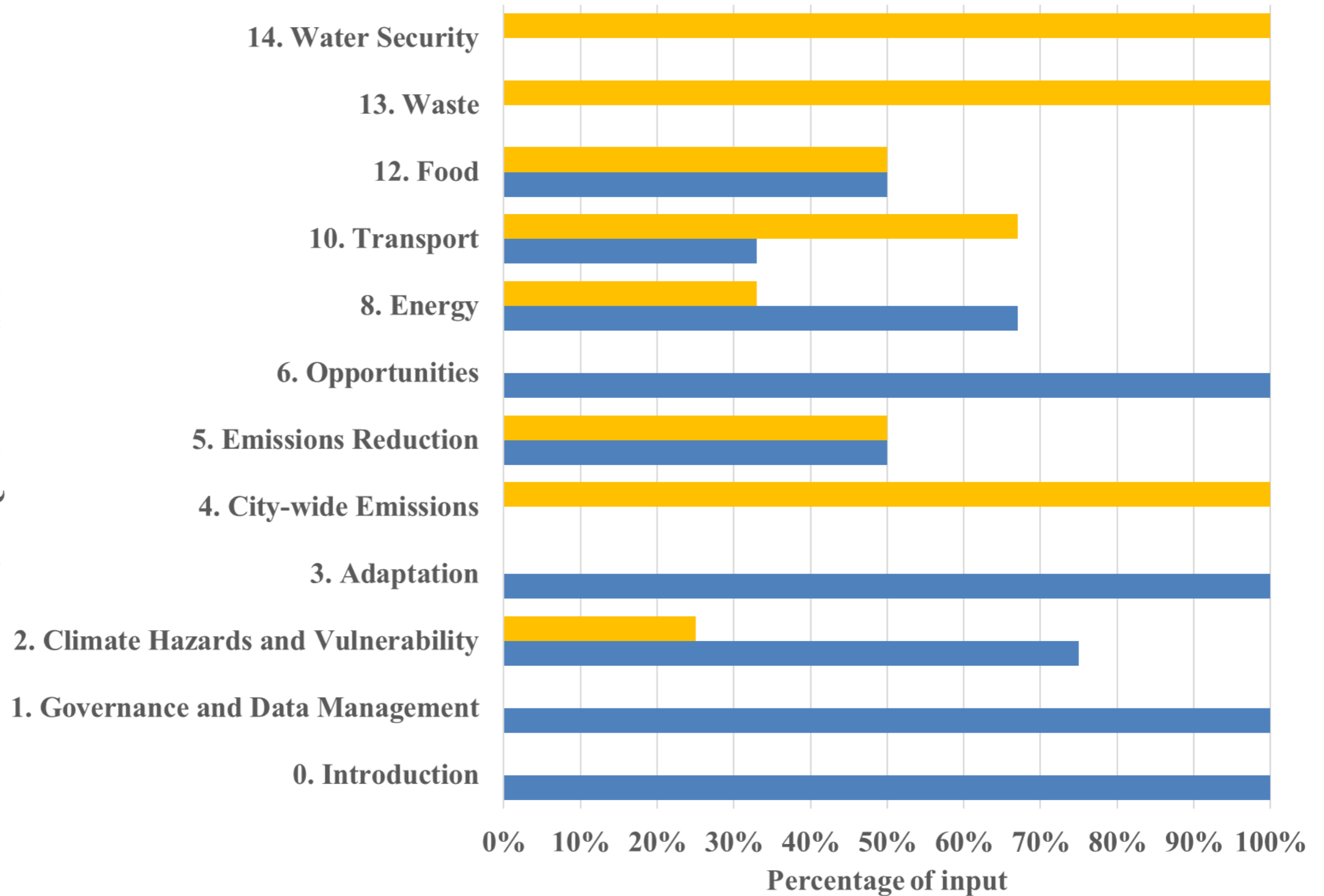

- Relevant questions
- Incorporation of information
- Final review

- Acceptance of final version
