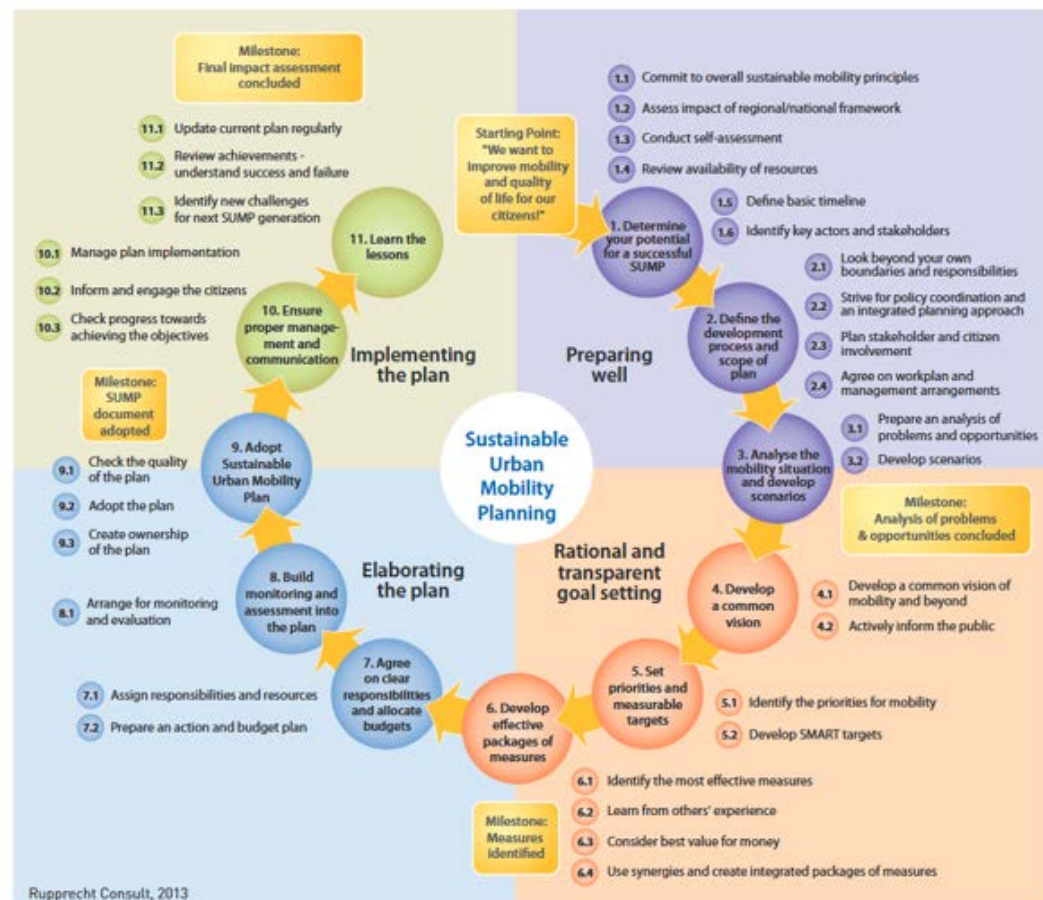
Going through the SUMP cycle – a challenge?

... however there are also common elements that result from implementing the SUMP cycle steps and activities that form important parts of SUMP.

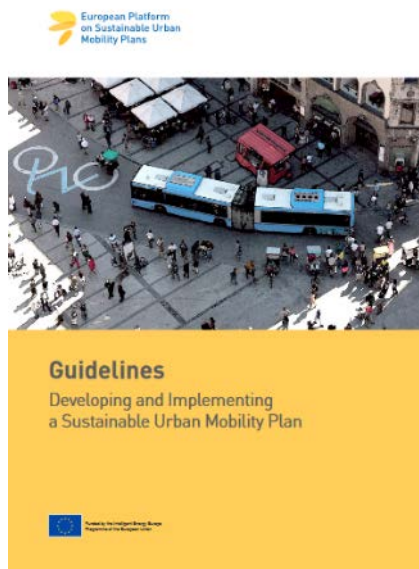

Guidelines



Start - Beginner Cities

This offers examples and suggestions on conducting measure selection for a first SUMP, possible measures to consider, grading these measures, and gaining approval for their implementation.

Step-up - Intermediate Cities

This gives advice on applying a more systematic approach to measure selection, finding synergies between different measure types and policy areas, and integrating measures from new fields into what has already been done in a city.

Innovate - Advanced Cities

This focuses on finding ways to cooperate with stakeholders and the public and open up participation, approaches that help realise the implementation of new ideas, and devising strategies to foster innovation and reach beyond the transport sector.
