Travelling to Turku

ARRIVAL BY PLANE | Turku international airport offers direct connections to/from Helsinki* (Finnair), Riga (AirBaltic), Gdansk (Wizzair), and Stockholm (SAS), and is located 8,5 km from the city centre. The regular bus connection (line 1), departing from the terminal every 15-20 minutes (check next available bus), is available daily for the single ticket price of 3 EUR (contactless card payment or mobile app Föli); approximate time of journey to the city centre (Kauppatori) is 15-20 minutes. Taxi stand can be found right outside the terminal or ordered by calling +358 0200 10041; the approximate cost of the ride to the city centre is 30-35 euro. Alternatively, you could use Uber to grab yourself a ride, the prices are sometimes cheaper than taxis.

*to reduce CO2 emissions, Helsinki-Turku connections are offered as a bus transfer. This information can be checked when booking the flight through the Finnair website.

ARRIVAL BY FERRY FROM STOCKHOLM | Ferries connecting Stockholm with Turku operate every day by <u>Viking Line</u> and <u>Silja Line</u>. Bus connection (line 1 & 1B), departing from the ferry terminal every 5-10 minutes during the peak times (<u>check the next available bus</u>), is available to the city centre (Kauppatori) for a single ticket price of 3 EUR (card payment or mobile app <u>Föli</u>) and the ride takes 10-15 minutes.

ARRIVAL BY BUS FROM HELSINKI VANTAA AIRPORT | Bus schedules can be checked and tickets booked from www.matkahuolto.fi/en/ (there are often discounts for online tickets purchases, compared to tickets bought from the driver): the departing station "Helsinki Airport (Vantaa)" and arrival stop closest to the city centre is "Turku Tuomiokirkko" (Cathedral). The approximate travel time is 2h 30min and might involve a change of the bus (the driver will normally announce when it happens).

The same website also provides bus connections from the Kamppi bus station in Helsinki centre.

ARRIVAL BY TRAIN FROM HELSINKI VANTAA AIRPORT | Train schedules can be checked, and tickets booked from www.vr.fi/en/ (tickets are cheaper if bought online in advance than from the station at the departure). The approximate travel time from the airport is 2h 30min and involves the change of the train at Pasila station in Helsinki (approx. after 20 min of travel). From the same website train connections from the main railway station in the centre of Helsinki can be checked as well.

<u>Please note that currently there is construction work between Turku (Central) and Kupittaa stations</u>. The railway line is closed between Turku and Kupittaa, and trains to Helsinki arrive and depart from the Kupittaa station instead of Turku central railway station (the Kupittaa station is located in Turku, 5 min drive, 15 minutes by bus or 30 min walk from the Kauppatori main square).

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION IN TURKU | Local buses are operated by the **Föli** company, its schedules and stops can be checked using the Föli planner website: www.foli.fi/en or by using Google Maps. Bus tickets (regular price 3 EUR) can be purchased directly on the bus by using contactless payment, or with cash (4 EUR) from the driver. Another payment option for buses is the mobile app Föli (available for Android and iOS, www.payiq.net/turku).







FÖLLARI – TURKU CITY BIKES | There are 700 bikes and more than 100 bike stations in the renewed Turku city bike system.
