Travel Recommendations

If you fly to **Tallinn**: Lennart Meri Airport is located in 180 km from Tartu; the bus can be booked in advance via https://luxexpress.eu/en, leave from the airport and arrive in 2h 30 min to Tartu bus terminal, which is situated in 2−5 min walking distances from hotels. The price of a single bus ticket is around 15−20 €.

If you fly to **Riga**: Riga airport is located 254 km from Tartu, which can be reached by bus in about 4 hours. According to an online search of flight schedules, Europe - Riga Airport connections may be more convenient for travel on 12 and 14 February. In order for you to be able to fully participate in the event, we will book a Riga - Tartu - Riga shuttle bus. Please indicate your preference on the registration form. Optionally, there is a https://luxexpress.eu/en connection directly from airport or via Riga Central station, but the connections are not frequent.

Event venue

<u>VSpa conference centre</u> is located in the centre of Tartu, at Riia 2, Tartu 51004. Event will be held in Sweden and Baltic area of the centre.

Accomodation

VSpa Hotel

The venue hotel VSpa located 4 min walking distance from Tartu bus terminal. Reservation and discounted price are active until February 1st 2024 based on the keyword EMPEREST. Reservations can be made at info@vspahotel.ee or +372 677 6677. The special offer does not apply to reservations made through online channels!

- Deluxe double room 140€/night

The main difference between Superior and Deluxe rooms is that Superior rooms have showers in their bathrooms, while Deluxe rooms have jacuzzis. Deluxe rooms also have the added value of a glass wall separating the bathroom and living area. In each room, you'll find a comfortable armchair or a wider sofa bed that can be used as an extra bed.

Prices include a healthy and rich breakfast at the hotel's restaurant JOYCE, access to the V Spa relaxation and sauna world (on the day of arrival from 16:00 to 22:00 and on the day of departure from 9:00 to 12:00), bathrobes, slippers, and a spa bag in the room, complimentary bottled water, Wi-Fi, and VAT.
