Tools for Urban Climate Adaptation Training Days

Staying resilient and mitigating vulnerability of urban areas to the changing climate is a challenge faced by all cities. What is direct and indirect impact of climate change on the urban areas? How can we better prepare to meet the challenges with adequate tools and skills? What are the possibilities and constraints to the adaptation?

The initiative *Urban Climate Change Adaptation in the Baltic Sea Region* focuses on connecting decision makers and local practitioners engaged in climate change adaptation to train them in a set of risk management approaches. In the framework of the project, training workshops are organized in the Baltic Sea Region for cities to learn how to apply bottom-up methodologies on adaptation to climate change at the municipality or regional levels.

During the organized training, participants will share challenges faced in their cities in relation to the climate change adaptation, and discuss them with the providers of the methodologies. Participants will be familiarized with the existing bottom-up methodologies that can be applied in cities. Presented regional and local cases will provide knowledge and inspiration in adopting cities to the climate change.

The training is free of charge and held in English.

We warmly invite cities of the Baltic Sea Region to join this workshop. The event will be particularly interesting to experts working with the climate change adaptation, water management and infrastructure, and sustainable development.
