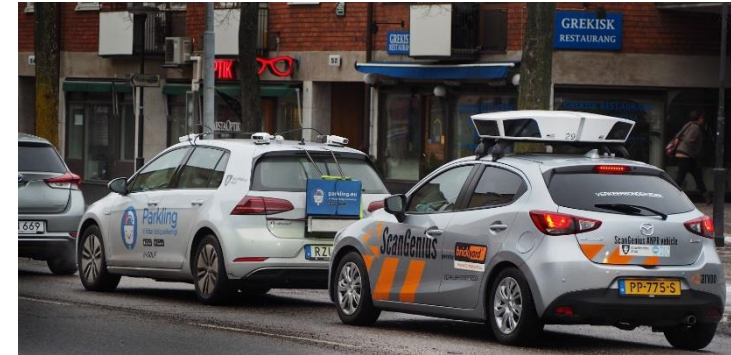
What does the project do?

What do we do in Stockholm?

- **Planning, streets and parking**

- Demonstrate new monitoring system
- Evaluation of "green parking standards" and pilot cargo-bike service to reduce car journeys



- **Walking and cycling**

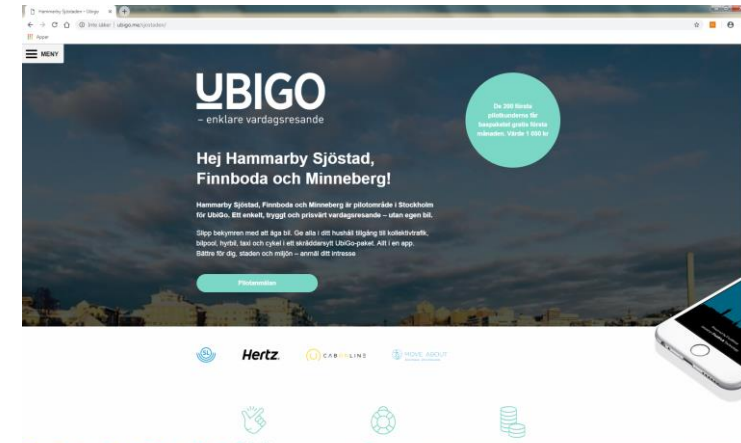
- Test methods and materials for safe re-routing of pedestrians and cyclists around construction sites
- Test fleet e-bikes



What do we do in Stockholm?

• Mobility services

- SnappCar and GoMore develop their services for car-sharing and ride-sharing
- Ubigo launch a "MaaS" service in Årsta – families can subscribe to monthly tickets offering public transport, taxi, car hire, car-sharing etc. in one app.



• Public transport

- Improvements to bus routes 178-179 linking key peripheral districts.

What do we do in Stockholm?

• Electric vehicles and charging infrastructure

- Improvements to miljöfordon.se
- Test fleet with 15 companies: tradesmen driving electric vans
- Regional campaign to install charging in private housing
- Map enabling development of charging network



• Logistik

- Night deliveries with plug-in hybrid truck
- Pre-study of requirement for municipal consolidation and consolidation of excavated masses using barges

Public charging – on street

- Access right agreements
- 5 years
- Fast charging standards: CHAdeMO, CCS and AC 43
- Normal charging: 3.7 – 22 kW
- Give data to the city – possible to evaluate
